

## Arriving at Berlin Tegel (TXL):

After your arrival at Berlin Tegel airport you should take the Bus (TXL) to Berlin Main Station (Berlin Hbf). The Bus ride will take about 25 min. From Berlin Main Station you should take a regional express train to travel to Rostock Main Station. The last train/bus to Rostock Main Station (Rostock Hbf) leaves at 18:36 LT from the airport and arrives at 21:23 LT at Rostock. The last Bus (line 121) to Kühlungsborn Station East (Kühlungsborn, Bhf Ost) departs from the central bus station (Southeast exit of Rostock Main Station) at 21:50 LT (see map Rostock ZOB).

The tickets for the German Railway as well as a complete plan of all further stages of your journey to Kühlungsborn including also all bus routes you find on the following webpage:

You just need to enter TXL Berlin Airport and your destination (Ostseebad Kühlungsborn Ost).

There are also terminals at the platforms or station where you can purchase tickets. However, please be aware that the ticket price for DB Bahn is just valid for the railway. The bus has to be paid separately at the driver!!!! Bus and taxi can usually not be paid with credit card !!!!
